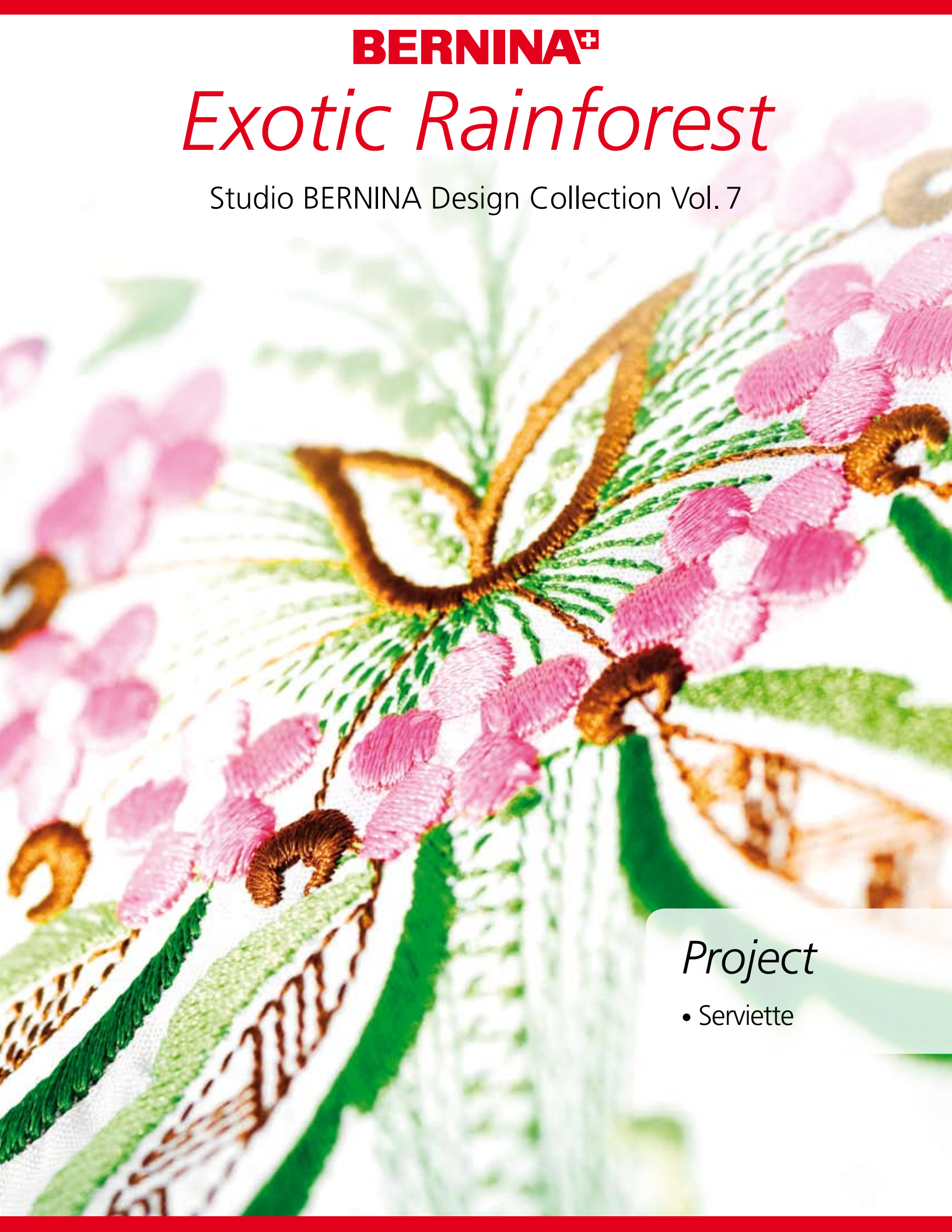

Serviette

Sewing instructions

You will need:

Embroidery design: BE10732

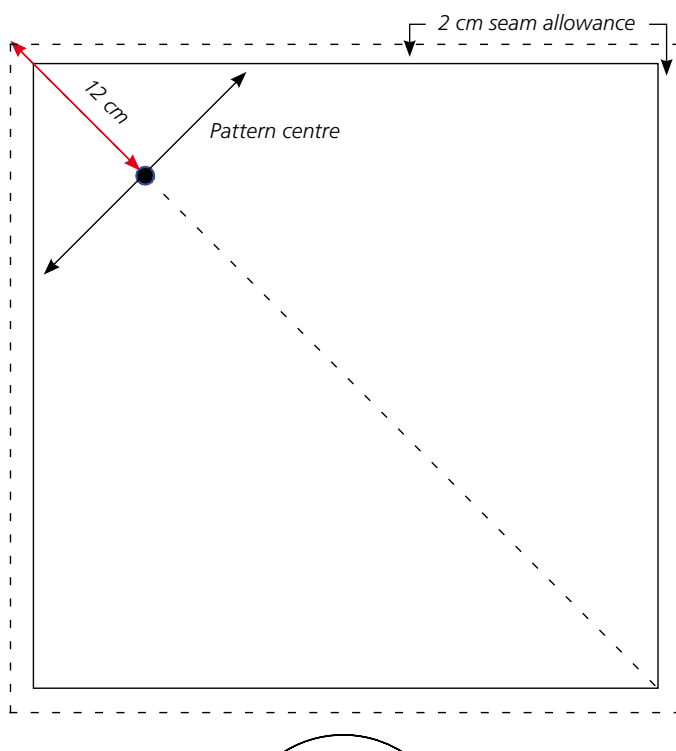
Embroidery hoop: Medium-Hoop

Fabric: 54 cm x 54 cm

Embroidery thread: See thread colour chart

Embroidery stabiliser: Tear-away

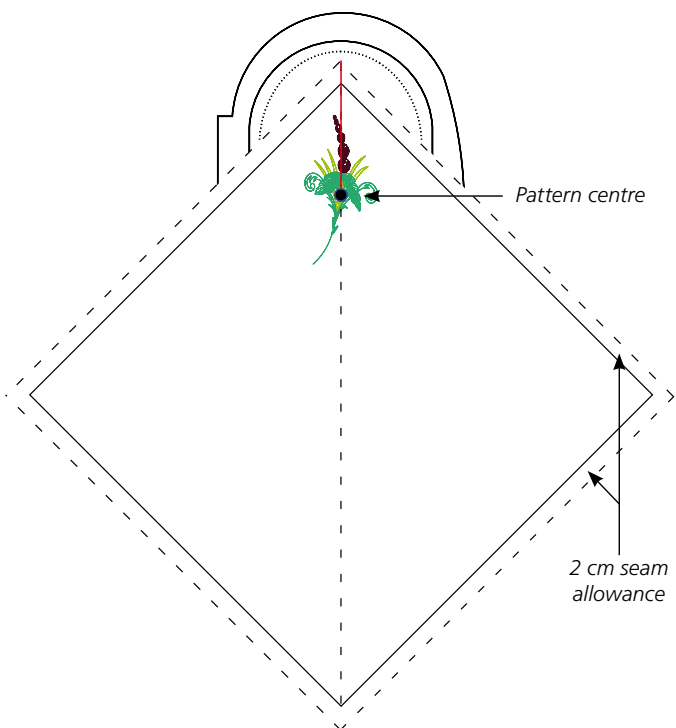
Spray adhesive: 505



Mark embroidery start point:

Mark in a diagonal line. Starting from the corner, measure 12 cm (only 10 cm for a ready-made serviette) and mark the pattern centre.

The fabric or the ready-made serviette is not hooped, but is attached to the stabiliser which has been sprayed with spray adhesive. This ensures that no fabric is used unnecessarily, and that no extra piece of fabric need be sewn onto a ready-made serviette so that it can be hooped.



Hoop the embroidery stabiliser. Mark in the vertical and horizontal centre lines on the stabiliser with the aid of the hoop template. Spray the stabiliser with a little spray adhesive. Attach the fabric or the ready-made serviette to the stabiliser so that the marked lines of the fabric and stabiliser as well as the pattern centre coincide.

Rotate design BE10732 45° to the right in the embroidery software or on the machine, then centre it. Select the pattern centre on the embroidery computer. Position the needle on the marked pattern centre and embroider the design.
